Schools Partnership Opportunities Beyond (2017-2018)

Partner Schools Tournaments:

Partner School students can participate in two annual tournaments each year at Fencers Club. These tournaments give students the chance to fence “electric” and put what they’ve learned into practice on the strip.

Dates: January and June (both Sundays, approx. 1:00-5:00PM) – dates TBD

Ages: open to all Partner School students. First 50 students to register will receive a free Fencers Club T-shirt when they check-in on tournament day.

Fees: FREE registration for first 50 students to register. \$20 late registration or at the door fee per fencer (need-based scholarships available)

More Info: Students should bring their fencing equipment from school. If not, limited rental equipment will be available for a \$10 rental fee per fencer.

Weekly Fencing Enrichment Program:

Open to all beginner fencers ages 7-15, this program is taught by our elite athletes and School Coaches to provide extra fencing practice for those students who show a passion for fencing. All necessary fencing equipment is provided.
