We seek Fencers Club members who are passionate about teaching, mentoring and connecting with children in a meaningful way to make a positive impact.

Eligibility for participation:

The program was designed to support our competitive athletes while they are attending schools, and/or pursuing professional careers in conjunction with active competitive pursuits. The program is open to Fencers Club members and members must submit to a background check verification.

School Coaching Fees:

Schools Coaches work as independent contractors. The coaching fees vary based on experience, commitment, and effectiveness:

1 hour class: 25 to 100 90 min class: 40 to 100 2 hour class: 50 to 150
