FENCERS CLUB NON-MEMBER/GUEST POLICY

Effective 9/1/2019

General rules for non-members:

- Unless specified below*, non-member fencer must sign in at the front office and pay \$50 club's evening fencing fee prior to open bouting.
- For paying non-members, open bouting starts at 7:00 PM.
- The club has the right to limit the number to 10 evening fencers to prevent overcrowding for effective and efficient training. Please send email info@fencersclub.org to inquire.

- Must be a current USFA member
- Fencers Club reserves the right to deny entrance to anyone who does not follow FC rules, policies and/or procedures.

*Guests who are exempt from the club's evening fencing fee:

Once per week for open bouting to start at 7:30PM:

- All current US National Team Members
- Foreign National Team Members with minimum 4 FIE Senior points or minimum 16 Junior points in current FIE point standings. All foreign college students must meet this standard.
- NYAC members on the guest list for open bouting.

ALL guests must follow FC rules when club is crowded and fence with FC members when requested.
