1:15 PM to 3:45 PM - Fencing

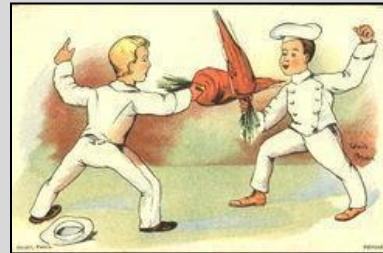

Campers can also bring their lunch on Fridays, if they prefer. Please make sure bags/containers are clearly labeled with the camper's name. Campers can keep lunches in our refrigerator until lunchtime. Campers will be expected to clean up after lunch.

Please let camp staff know before camp if a camper has any dietary restrictions and food allergies. A water fountain is available throughout the day to ensure campers stay hydrated during all activities.

What Should I Wear?

For fencing, all campers must wear long pants (no jeans), leggings or fencing knickers. They must also have socks and sneakers/tennis shoes. If you have your own fencing equipment, please bring it! If not, Fencers Club will provide fencing gear.

Fencers Club Code of Conduct and Honor for Camps

Revised July 2024

The types of behavior and conduct that are prohibited or considered inappropriate during camp include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. Theft or inappropriate removal or possession of Fencers Club or camp property.
 2. Withholding knowledge or information on any inappropriate actions or behavior by campers, employees and/or independent contractors—an incident must be reported to the Executive Director or Camp Manager immediately.
 3. Fencing or participating in camp sessions under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs or any other violation of the FC Drugs, Narcotics and Alcohol policy.
 4. Any form of unlawful harassment and/or discrimination or other unlawful or unwelcome conduct.
 5. Insubordination or other disrespectful conduct.
 6. Fighting, using obscene, abusive language, gestures or threatening violence.
 7. Negligence or improper conduct leading to damage of property.
 8. Boisterous or disruptive activity in the camp environment.
- **Hospitality** - All Fencers Club staff and campers will graciously extend themselves to welcome other campers, members, visitors, and newcomers to the sport of fencing.
 - **Safety** - All Fencers Club staff and campers will place safety first in the maintenance of their equipment and their personal behavior while at camp.
 - **Civility** - All Fencers Club staff and campers will treat themselves, each other, and our facility with the highest degree of respect. We will all leave our club and camp facilities cleaner than when we arrived.
 - **Responsibility** - All Fencers Club staff and campers must abide by this code of conduct and conduct themselves in an appropriate manner at all times while at camp.

NOTE: Fencers Club reserves the right to dismiss a camper if the camper's behavior interferes with the rights of others, the smooth functioning of the group or activity, or violates the camp's code of conduct. No refunds or transfer of funds will be made for withdrawal, dismissal, failure to attend, or incomplete attendance.
